COH operates as a high-frequency, predictable access point in Calgary's urban core, providing continuous access that partner organizations and individuals depend on.

How the Hub Works

Centralized Access

A single low-barrier environment. No appointments, referrals, or prerequisites. Walk-in access five days per week.

Partner Coordination

Partner organizations deliver services under a shared governance structure. COH coordinates presence, alignment, and operating standards.

Peer-Led Engagement

Peer workers maintain trust and relational continuity, keeping individuals connected over time and enabling follow-through on services.

Services include meals, clothing, hygiene, community nursing, foot care, wound care, STBBI testing, housing referrals, and culturally grounded programming. All delivered by partner organizations within the Hub.
